Free School Delivery (FSD)

Alleycatz will offer a free school delivery and collection service once a week on a Friday during term time- please order by the end of the previous week. There is an option to select FSD at checkout- which will require you to provide the student's name and tutor group. Another key reason that we are passionate about our partnership with Alleyatz is that, from January 2022, any new Trinity Academy blazer that is made will be coming from a manufacturer called David Luke Schoolwear. In 2010 David Luke Schoolwear was the first business within the industry to introduce recycled polyester to its product portfolio when they created the Eco-blazer. This means that 100% of the polyester that is used to manufacture the blazer comes from recycled plastic bottles instead of crude oil. The process Depolymerisation is a process which allows you to take a plastic bottle back to its original state of crude oil. Polymerisation follows the same process in reverse, allowing it to be a component of an

Eco-fabric. The average number of non-biodegradable plastic drinking bottles used in making each blazer is 18, which would otherwise end up in landfill. Click [HERE](#) to find out more.

Guidance for All

Our dress is smart and business-like to show our respect and care of ourselves and our community. When dressed in their uniform, pupils are representing Trinity Academy and they should look smart and well-presented at all times.

All pupils must wear the correct school uniform to and from school and during the school day. This will also be a requirement for school trips, unless otherwise specified.

All school uniform and physical education kit must be clearly marked with the student's full name. All equipment and footwear must also be named and this will be checked during the student's first lessons.

School physical education uniform must be worn for all PE and Games lessons, after school sports sessions and matches.

The decision of the Headteacher is final and students may not be allowed to participate in the school day if they are not wearing the correct uniform. If this occurs students may be lent uniform or asked to return home to change (following parental contact).

Daywear

Compulsory

- Grey blazer with embroidered school badge to be worn at all times (available from AlleyCatz only). *Students are expected to wear their blazers at all times around the school unless permission to remove it is granted by a member of staff. Blazer sleeves should not be rolled up.*
- Knee-length tartan skirt (available from AlleyCatz only). *This is to be worn on or below the knee.*
- Tailored black trousers (for boys or girls). *Straight, skinny leg trousers , capri-style, 'ankle grazers', cropped, leggings or jeggings are not acceptable.*
- School tie (available from AlleyCatz only), *to be tied up to collar and normal length with seven stripes showing.*
- Plain white shirt with buttons to the neck and standard collar. *Must be tucked in at all times. Top button done up at all times.*
- Black or grey plain tights, no stockings or hold ups are permitted. Tights with holes and/or ladders are unacceptable.
- Black socks only. No sports socks, trainer socks or over the knee socks.

Optional

- Black v-neck pullover with stripe (available from AlleyCatz only)

Shoes

Please check with the school if there are any queries regarding the suitability of footwear. We will insist on student's wearing appropriate footwear. Students will not be allowed to participate in the school day in inappropriate footwear and will either be provided with alternative footwear or asked to return home in order to change.

- All students should wear black low-heeled polishable or patent shoes
- Ballet pumps, boots, suede shoes or trainers are not acceptable
- Heel height should not exceed 4cm
- Markings and logos are not permitted
- Soles, laces and stitchings on shoes should be black only

Sportswear

Compulsory

- Black and purple round neck short-sleeved sports top with school badge (available from AlleyCatz only).
- Black and purple shorts or skort (available from AlleyCatz only).
- Black leggings or track pants. These can either be with school badge (available from AlleyCatz only) or plain black (no branding or other logos permitted)
- Black and purple socks (available from AlleyCatz only).
- Black socks for PE
- Shin pads.

Trainers for PE (no fully black-soled trainers allowed as they will mark the sports hall) must be sports trainers, not fashion trainers such as Nike Air force, Jordans Vans or converse. Trainers will be advertised as 'non marking' and if in doubt, please ask in-store BEFORE purchasing



Optional

- Black and purple zip up jacket (available from AlleyCatz only).
- Black track pants with school badge embroidered under pocket (available from AlleyCatz only).
- Black leggings with school badge at the bottom of the leg (available from AlleyCatz only).
- Plain black base layers.
