Assessment

At the end of year 2

- **Listening, reading and writing:** 2 Hours 30 minutes. 700 marks- 50% of A-Level
- **Writing:** 2 hours. 80 marks-20% of A-Level. One text and one film or two texts. Grammar.
- **Speaking:** Individual research project. 27-23 minutes (including 5 preparation minutes). 60 marks- 30% of A-Level
