Teams will be judged on various criteria such as the distance flown, innovative design, use of recycled materials, flight physics, and more which will be detailed by the students in a poster presentation. Winning teams from each regional Fly-Off get the chance to compete at the Grand Final. Every student participating in the FSC will also receive from the committee a certificate in Glider Flight Engineering.
